**February 21 at 6pm-** The Official Bib Draw will be held at the Hard Rock Cafe on the corner of 4<sup>th</sup> and E. You are welcome to attend!

The following itinerary will be your guide to this experience. Sunday evening at 6pm is the Awards Ceremony & Banquet, where you will be our guests and recognized as dignitaries. You will again have the option to socialize with your musher.

**10:30am** – Meet at the Rondy Hospitality Room. You will be met by a Rondy Board Member and a representative from the Alaskan Sled Dog Racing Association.

At this meeting, you will be given your credentials and prepare to head down to the Start Area to meet your Musher. The Rondy Hospitality Room will be open Friday, Saturday and Sunday and will be a good place for you to warm up and have a cup of coffee during the Race.

**10:45am** – Start Area to Meet your Musher! We will escort you to the start area to meet the musher who you will be handling for and you will spend time getting to know your musher and his team. Your musher will instruct you on what you can do to help at the line. Feel free to ask questions!

**11:45am – 12:45pm** (approximately) – When it is time for your musher to prepare for his or her start, we will proceed to the bleachers at the starting line. You will be on hand to assist your musher when their team is at the line. After your musher has left the line, please move back to the bleachers area to allow the next team and K-9 Crew to advance without delay.

After all of the teams are out, there will be other activities in the area, so please feel free to enjoy your seating at the bleachers for these events, or head up to the Rondy Hospitality Room for a cup of coffee.

**1:25pm** (approximately) the teams will begin to return and cross the finish line. Keep an eye out for the Trail Guard at Cordova to raise her flag, signaling that a dog team is in sight. When the teams are in, please feel free to move back into the Staging Area to meet with your musher to discuss the race and lend a hand if needed.
